Don't EVER Burn:

- ◆ Garbage, paper and cardboard
- ◆ Building materials, including lumber and wood scraps
- ◆ Tires, other rubber products, asphalt shingles, and heavy oils
- ◆ Paints, household and agricultural chemicals
- ◆ Wire, plastics and synthetic materials

Reduce, Reuse, Recycle

**Brush can be composted,
ground up for mulch, or
just left to rot.**

**Newspapers can be
recycled. Old junk can be
given away for reuse.**
